4.1 Case Law Update - Denny v Optus Mobile Pty Ltd [2023] NSWLEC 27

That the Local Planning Panel note the case law update and recommendations following the recent decision of the Land and Environment Court in Denny v Optus Mobile Pty Ltd [2023] NSWLEC 27.

Panel Decision:

- 1. The update from Council was noted.
- 2. The Panel confirmed that it should have the opportunity to provide instructions on any appeals against Panel decisions, that Council should monitor the progress of all appeals, and that Council should come back to the Panel for further instructions if matters do not proceed as expected.
- 3. Requested Council to come back to the Panel with a revised template recommendation for Clause 4.6 matters; and
- 4. Requested Council to ensure that each assessment report contains a conclusion which explains the rationale for Council's recommendation(s) in a manner informed by the lessons from this case.
